

Hi, Everyone.

I hope you've had a good week. Our theme this time is Creation. As usual there are videos, activities and prayers to help you explore God's creation with your children. Genesis 1 and 2 give us stories about creation, but in Proverbs 8:1, 22-31 wisdom is seen playing alongside God as God creates the world. It's a great poetic image - have a read!

Attached is a reflective picture of Psalm 150, created by Mina Munns. Print it off and colour it together as you think about creation.

You might want to enjoy a different one of the following ideas each day, but here's a suggestion for how you might use them:

- Go for a walk. Pick up some things that remind you of creation - or take some photos. When you get back, arrange them on a 'Creation Table'.
- Read the story of creation in a Bible (Genesis 1) or a Bible story book, or watch one of the videos.
- Talk together about your favourite things in creation. Create a creation picture or collage or model from things you have around your home.
- Use one of the ideas from Creative Flame, or think how you could use the RSPB ideas for caring for God's creation.
- Finish by praying together: Creator God, thank you for your world. We are sorry that we don't always care for it. Help us to protect it. Amen.
- Say the Lord's Prayer together.
